

**Fumaria capreolata*

WHITEFLOWER FUMITORY

L.

Flowering period: August–November.

Description: Robust, scrambling herb lacking rigidity in the stems and leaves, and prone to bruising with leaves highly dissected to 1.5 cm long. Flowers in racemes up to 20-flowered, producing abundant, 2 mm wide seeds.

Pollination: Open pollinated by a variety of insects.

Distribution: Widespread weed of protected, moist areas in secondary dunes often smothering understorey plants in *Acacia* groves.

Control: Can be controlled with application of herbicides; however, hand pulling can be effective for controlling localised outbreaks. Minimising soil disturbance may assist in limiting the spread of this troublesome weed.
