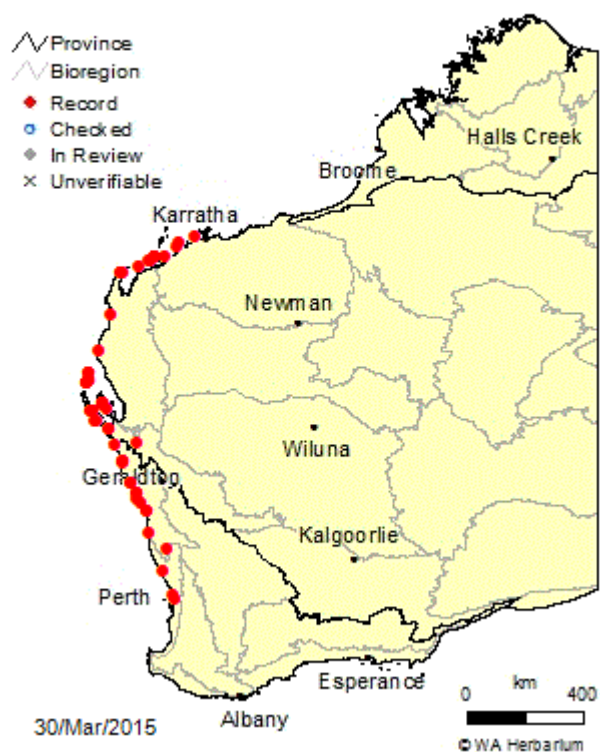

Much-branched, bushy shrub, 0.2-0.5 m high. Fl. yellow, Feb to Aug or Nov to Dec. Sand. Coastal limestone & sand dunes, salt pans.

Beard's Provinces: Eremaean Province, South-West Province.

IBRA Regions: Carnarvon, Geraldton Sandplains, Swan Coastal Plain, Yalgoo.
