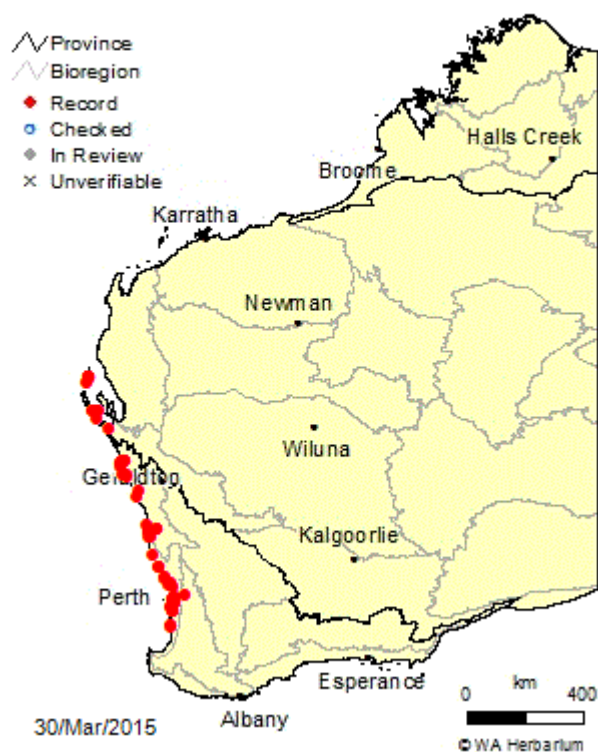

Rigid, much-branched, prickly shrub, to 0.6 m high. Fl. white, Jul to Aug. Brown to yellow sand, sandy clay, limestone. Coastal areas, river flats, near salt lakes.
