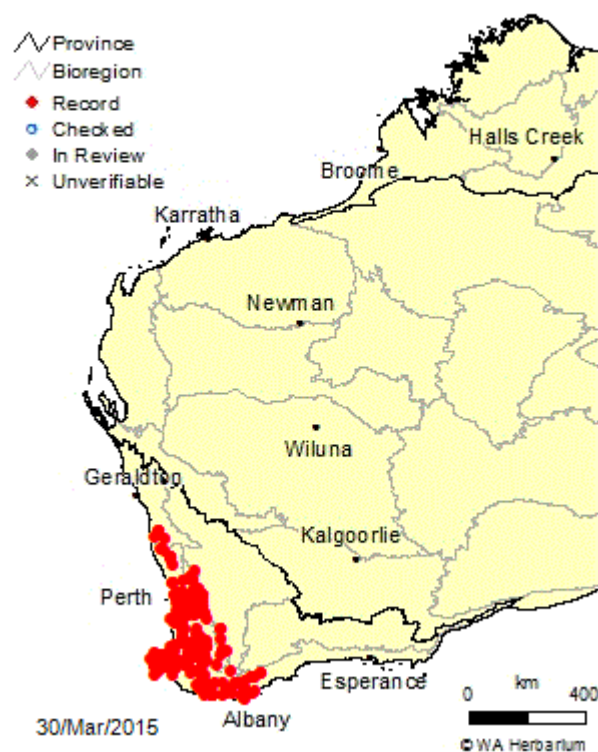

Rhizomatous, tufted perennial, grass-like or herb (sedge), 0.15-1.2 m high. Fl. brown-black, May to Nov. White, grey or lateritic sand, loam, granite, gravel. Swamps, rocky hillsides.
